Old minutes: Approved.

Treasurer's Report: From the period between [07/11/13](#) and [08/07/2013](#), TCDPS received \$25 in dues and had expenses of .85 for Paypal fees. Account balances total: \$14,610.51.

Membership: we have 122 members current with their dues.

Media: Eric Fahsl reported an increase from Kennewick browsers to the website, as well as more site searching. Pooch Plunge information has been added to the website. On Facebook page, rants and advertising will be deleted. Dave Cazier is working on a TCDPS message to go to new Facebook members.

Parks Department: Dave met with Phil Pinard and Jen and the city is still working on the park rules. The park gate issue has been fixed. Englewood road work is supposed to be completed by the end of August. A water line has barely started for the drinking fountains. The fountains are supposed to be installed in late August or early September. More trash cans are coming. Finally, the dog park is being moved to the top of the 'needs improvement' list. Phil and Jen are developing a grounds plan for the park.

Pooch Plunge: Still have had no reply from owner of Jackson's Sport Bar about using their reader board. TCDPS has 653' of mature orange fencing, plus 84 metal posts. Bill Bell indicated that he had sufficient twist ties. No more vendors can be accepted. Vendors are Between the Buns, Critters, Soyon Jewelry, Hugs'nTugs Pet Harnesses, and Puptown Pet Grooming. Dock Dogs and E. WA. Boxer Rescue will have table there. Will get form signatures in the next week from city and park dept. Gave list of time slots available to Suzanne LeFevre for her students to volunteer for. Need two boxes of poop bags and TCDPS brochures. Dave will provide music, and has prepared a press release. Lynsey has 5 gift baskets for silent auction.

Fundraising: Lynsey reported that Shakey's will give a portion of their proceeds to the Society on Sept. 26, from 4-8.

Parks Partnership Program: The drinking fountains have been ordered.
