Phase II Update

- Spigots update
 - Been repaired, irrigation water, can use a hose on it
 - Every other spigot is clean water
- Tree order updates
 - Nov. 6-10
 - 12 trees- 3 in small, 9 trees in large
- Fence completion date and status
 - Should be done by Friday
 - City will provide latches to Frontier
- Signs
 - Generic city sign on every gate
 - Visual dog sign for small park
 - Label each park on every gate
 - Dog waste sign throughout all the parks
 - Both the city and TCDPS logos will be on the sign
 - Signs on how to get to the dog park
- TCDPS payment
 - \$30,000
 - Owe \$12,000
 - Came in under budget
 - Put money into the pavement of the parking lot?
 - Concrete pads will have a section that will make accessing the spigots easy for the city
 - Lighting the park would cause more turf damage, is it worth it?
 - You pay per light
 - Can't do trees/shrubs under the power lines
 - The trees were bought through a different fund, we could donate some money for trees to go up in other parks
 - If we do gate lights, we could couple the lights with the parking lot lights
 - Spend money on the Kiosks at the entrance of each park
 - Put money down on the portapotty
 - Try grass pavers at the entrances instead of the concrete to help prevent erosion
 - Possibly put some money into more benches
 - Getting a quote on webcam pull

Adopt-a-Park

- Contract updates and revisions
 - No insurance
 - Renting the park for a birthday: Establish a rental rate, close one of the small dog parks, create a rental agreement,
 - Get the city contact information or the P.O. box
- Changes to agreement
