Meeting Minutes Approved

City Of Richland Parks & Facilities Department:

- Paws-abilities Place address updated
 - City of Richland had an official address given to the Park
 - Aliases were given to the dog park, so when someone calls 911, they are able to say a variety of names and the dispatcher will be able to reach them
- Gazebo project update
 - Behind schedule, was intentional because the city has funds that they would be able to use for the curb and sand update around the gazebo

- Plan to have it done by the end of the year
- New park rule cards
 - The cards have the new rules on them and will be passed around the park when possible

TCDPS Updates:

- Small park size limit signs
 - Sign was made for phase 1 small park
 - The phase 2 small dog park height sign was lowered from 14 inches to 12 inches
- Vandalism and thefts at the park
 - Bowls are being chained up
- Fundraiser updates
 - The week after Thanksgiving, there will be a scentsy fundraiser. Half of what is made will be given to the dog park
- December meeting has been cancelled
 - In January, we will be discussing bi-monthly meetings

Votes:

- Tables
 - The tables are starting to break and go bad
 - We discussed redoing all the tables with composite wood and reuse the frames or we could buy tables in the same material as the benches we recently got
 - Will tell the company we are a non-profit and attempt to get cheaper prices
 - Motion was approved to not exceed \$4,500 on new tables

Other Discussion:

- Message board doors are being replaced by the company for free
- Jason will keep the old plexiglass message board doors

- Discussed putting up each new rule on a sign to place around on the dog park fences
- The city wants to have an emphasis patrol weekend to come and talk to people who aren't following the rules
